Pastors / Congregations

We are:

- supporting and walking with congregations through their **call process**
- working with Lutheran Congregations in Mission for Christ (LCMC) leadership on identifying the factors within a congregation and pastoral ministry that make a *good nurturing place for future pastors*.



We are developing a **Congregations in Transition** Ministry Initiative. It:

- is designed for congregations *who do not have an interim pastor*
- provides coaches to walk congregations through the transition process
- trains Lutheran pastors (likely retired) to become coaches by:
 - recruiting
 - training
 - equipping
 - supporting.
- Training event planned for April 2019
