OUTREACH MINISTRIES

Do you feel good about what your congregation is doing given your financial resources and the number of available volunteers?

If not, is there any particular need in your community that you think should be addressed? Please explain.

CARE AND VISITATION MINISTRY

If this is not currently being covered are there members who would be able and willing to step forward for hospital visits and home calls on shut-ins? If yes, who might they be?

YOUR CONGREGATION'S MISSION

Recent quote from a small-church Lutheran pastor: "Congregations need to move from a survival mode to a mission mode...Are you looking beyond survival? If survival is your goal you will die...Mission is not necessarily growth."
